- In what areas could the coach/coaches improve?

 - Don't play favorites
 - Make practices more productive

 - More JV time for kids not playing much on varsity
 - Just coach and try not to let parents, admin, or school board influence them in their coaching decisions.
- How can the activities office further support the program you are involved in?
 - More gym time
 - Don't know/not sure/does great/supports well – multiple times
 - Change certain coaches (three times, multiple levels)
 - Be more involved with PYAA
 - Look at what kids are learning
 - More gym time
 - Better competition
 - Increase participation
 - More games (this is actually set by WIAA)
 - Listen to players and parents
 - Hire all out of school coaches
 - Don't let parents influence the coaches in any way
 - Remind all parents that this isn't a professional sport and everyone should play.
 - Shouldn't need a supervisor for gym/weight room
 - Observe and make suggestions to coaches
 - Entire group needs to go
- What did the coach do well this season?
 - 60 Responses
 - 47 Positive Responses
 - 13 Negative responses attacking coaches or simply saying nothing

- In what areas could the coach/coaches improve?
 - 58 Responses
 - 44 responses expressing areas that could be improved upon – anything from communication, strength training, listening to players, being more firm, etc.
 - 6 responses left blank, stating nothing, not much or I think they were perfect, or would be nice if the parents would support the coach but that isn't on the coach.
 - 4 responses essentially demanding firing of coaches
 - 4 responses attacking people personally
- How can the activities office further support the program you are involved in?
 - 47 Responses
 - 10 Responses left blank or unsure
 - 6 responses indicating great job, great support, etc
 - 17 comments regarding things to do better
 - Conflicting emails from r school
 - Get to know coaches better
 - Schedule better competition
 - No supervisor for weight room or gym should be needed
 - Make suggestions to coaches about who to play and who not to
 - More involved with PYAA
 - Allow more off-season opportunities (WIAA)

 - Different way to post schedules
 - 10 responses asking for coaches/other personnel to be fired
 - 4 responses related to things such as
