Cochrane-Fountain City School District Curriculum Committee Meeting November 26, 2018

Larry Cyrus called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Members present were Larry Cyrus, and Bonnie Breza, Karen Knospe arrived at 4:02 p.m. Others present included: Fayme Evenson, Steve Nehring, Steve Stoppelmoor, Tom Hiebert, Don Baloun and Sue Baloun.

Larry Cyrus gave an overview of the committee charges. Mr. Cyrus asked Mr. Nehring and Ms. Evenson to share the goals currently being worked on in curriculum. Mr. Hiebert spoke on Mental Health issues are being monitored by Mr. Kjelland and Financial Literacy is worked on in the 8th grade. He reported that Mr. Stoppelmoor gave a report to the board on ACT Scores and The School Report Card. On December 5th the School Board will have a special meeting on Curriculum and Programming topics. He mentioned Mr. Nelson will report on Tech Ed, Janell Gibson will report on Early Learning Center, Fayme Evenson will report on options to prepare for the ACT and District Report Card, Steve Nehring will report on District Testing Schedule and SIS (School Improvement Services) meeting Points of Emphasis. The committee thought Graduation Requirements and School Calendar (in-service days) should also be reported on at the special meeting.
