

Student Privacy

Cochrane-Fountain City School District respects each student's right to the confidentiality and privacy of their educational information. Consistent with our commitment and as required by Federal law, we will make every attempt to protect the privacy of student information so that such information is not heard, read, or otherwise shared with others for any reason other than to promote the best educational outcomes for our students.

Federal law requires the Cochrane-Fountain School District to notify you and allow you to opt your child out of participating in certain surveys (including certain evaluations) that would reveal information concerning any of the following:

- political affiliations or beliefs of the student or the student's parent or guardian;
- mental or psychological problems of the student or the student's family;
- sex behavior or attitudes;
- illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating or demeaning behavior;
- critical appraisals of other individuals with whom students have close family relationships;
- legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships such as those of lawyers, physicians and ministers;
- religious practices, affiliations or beliefs of the student or the student's parent or guardian; or
- income, other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under such a program.

If you DO NOT want your child to participate in any of the above-named survey activities that are applicable to your child, you should notify the building principal or designee in writing. Any parent or guardian may also inspect any of the above-named surveys, as well as any instructional materials used in connection with such surveys upon request. The building principal or designee shall respond to your request in a timely manner.
