Definitions and Details

1. **Parent Definition:** The term "parent" includes a legal guardian or other person standing in loco parentis (such as a grandparent or stepparent with whom the child lives, or a person who is legally responsible for the child's welfare).
2. **Armed Forces Definition:** Armed forces include the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard (10 U.S.C. 101(a)(4)).
3. **Active Duty Definition:** Active Duty means full-time duty in the active military service of the United States, including full-time training duty, annual training duty, and attendance, while in active military service, at a school designated as a service school by law (10 U.S.C. 101(d)(1)).
4. **Full-time National Guard Duty Definition:** Full-time National Guard Duty means training or other duty (except inactive duty) performed by a member of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard in the member's status as a member of National Guard of a state or territory, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or District of Columbia for which the member is entitled to pay or for which the member has waived pay (10 U.S.C. 101(d)(5)).
5. Families can indicate 'No' to all questions even if they are in the military, and they can indicate 'Yes' if they are not.

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
