Arcadia: The new superintendent has 12 month contract with a salary of \$125,000. Benefits include State Teacher's Retirement paid by the district (approx. 6.7% of salary; health insurance premiums of between \$641 and \$1,498; disability insurance of up to \$26.00. There is also a retirement plan but I was not provided with the details of that plan.
