The following scholarships are chosen by a committee of teachers at C-FC Schools. To apply for any of these scholarships, please fill out the attached cover page and complete the requirements for each scholarship.

To submit, place your cover page, a copy of your latest transcript and your activities resume in the left pocket and your individual scholarship applications in the right pocket of a two-pocket folder. Each *individual* scholarship application must contain a cover page with the name of the scholarship and your name in bold lettering at the top of the page and include the requirements for that scholarship as listed below. Scholarship application packets must be typewritten. Essays (unless indicated) should be no more than one page in length. All pages for a particular scholarship are to be stapled together.

All application materials for this packet are due by May 3, 2024.

<u>C-FC EDUCATORS (1 @ \$300)</u>

- *Preference will be given to a student pursuing a career in the education field.
- 1) A one paragraph statement from 2 C-FC teachers saying they recommend you for this scholarship.
- 2) Essay: Why have I chosen to pursue a career in the field of education? Include what level you will be pursuing...elementary or secondary and if secondary, the subject area. Content, neatness, and correct grammar are all important! The length should be approximately 200 words.

ELNA ACHENBACH MEMORIAL (1 @ \$1,250)

- *Applicant must have financial need (ie take part in the free/reduced meals program)
- 1) Essay: How would receiving this scholarship make a difference in my success during my first year of college?

ETHAN KOCHENDERFER MEMORIAL (1 @ \$300)

- *Preference will be given to an applicant majoring in agriculture or an ag-related field.
- 1) Essay: "How does my major field of study relate to the world of agriculture?"

EVERETT STECKEL MEMORIAL (1 @ \$200)

- *Applicant must be a C-FC athlete.
- *Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a career in education although anyone can apply.
- Essay: What qualities have I developed as an athlete that will help me be successful in my teaching career? (Students who are not pursuing a teaching degree should state in their essay what they plan to major in and how what they have learned as an athlete will apply to their future career success.)

LACROSSE MILLING (1 @ \$500)

- 1) Applicant must be in top 50% of class.
- 2) Applicant must be pursuing a degree in Business, Agriculture, Economics, Engineering, Computer Science or a related field of study.
- 2) Essay: Why have I chosen the field of study I am majoring in and how does it relate to my future goals

COCHRANE-BUFFALO CITY LIONS CLUB - (2 @ \$500, 2 @ \$300)

*Student can only receive 1 of the 4 offered scholarships, but may submit applications for both.

- 1. Two letters of recommendation required for each scholarship.
- 2. C-BC Lions Club Scholarship (2 @ \$500) Essay: What events have influenced my career choice?
- 3. C-BC Lions Club Good Citizens Scholarship (2 @ \$300) Essay: How has community service influenced my high school career and how will it shape my future? Also include a list of community service events you have participated in, outside school programs and then through school sponsored events.
